

**2017 Elementary Summer School  
Promotion/Retention Guidance**

<b>Intervention Summer School - Grade Kindergarten</b>			
<i>Policy - Advancement should be based on satisfactory performance, as identified by the Office of the Chief Academic Officer, considering the subjects of Language Arts and Mathematics. The decision not to advance a kindergarten student should be justified with appropriate documentation.</i>			
Summer School - SCS students in grade <b>K</b> that have not mastered 70% of the required skills in Language Arts <b>and</b> Math will be eligible for the program. Students must be low performing in <u>both</u> Language Arts and Math. See below:			
Course	Total Skills	Mastered Minimum of 70%	Not Mastered eligible for SS
ELA	48	34	33 or less
Math	46	32	31 or less

<b>Promotional Summer School - Grades 1 - 5</b>	
<i>Policy - Advancement should be based on satisfactory performance (grade of 70 or above) in <b>both Language Arts and Mathematics</b>. In the subject areas where this is not achieved, summer school attendance, where available, should be strongly recommended.</i>	
Summer School - SCS Elementary students in grades 1 - 5 are eligible for this program if they have failed Language Arts and/or Math	
Student Failed ONLY <b>Language Arts</b>	Student will take <b>Language Arts</b> for Promotion and <b>Math</b> for Intervention
Student Failed ONLY <b>Math</b>	Student will take <b>Math</b> for Promotion and <b>Language Arts</b> for Intervention
Student Failed <b>Language Arts and Math</b>	Student will take both courses failed for promotion ( <b>Language Arts and Math</b> )
